Supervisor Lisa Worden called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm, at the Rodman Community Hall.

**PRIVILEGE of the FLOOR-** None.

Councilman Stuart Tamblin made a motion to approve April minutes; Councilman Daniel Grandjean seconded the motion. All were in favor.

**DANC REPORT** – Shawn Thorton, General Manager, Solid Waste Division of Development Authority of the North Country (DANC), submitted a report for the month of April.

DANC received a total of 1,561 scale transactions, totaling 16,712.56 tons of material for April.

DANC diverted approximately 5,145.77 tons of waste from landfill this year.

There were 1,221,641 gallons of leachate hauled to the Watertown Treatment Plant in the month of April. The City of Watertown accepted 136 loads.

There were 35,19,070 gallons of leachate hauled to the City of Ogdensburg Treatment Plant in the month of April. The City of Ogdensburg accepted 4 loads.

DANC has recorded 3.61 inches of rain for the month of April.

**CTHC REPORT**—Angie Kimball, Circuit Rider for Tug Hill Council (CTHC), submitted a report for the month of April. (See attachment)

**Supervisor's Financial Report** – Supervisor Lisa Worden submitted a Monthly Report of Receipts and Payments for April, it was read and filed..

**Town Zoning Officer's Report**- Zoning Officer Andy Ondrasek submitted a report for the month of April.

Zoning Officer Andy Ondrasek has received two complaints, the first one on County Route 68 the second on County Route 156. Zoning Officer Andy Ondrasek will follow up on these complaints.

**Town Justice Report**- Judge Amy Simpson submitted a report for the month of April. Judge Amy Simpson presented the board with a check in the amount of \$1,273.00 for the month of April.

**Town Clerk's Report**- Jamie Ackley, Town Clerk, submitted a report for the month of April.

Town Clerk Jamie Ackley submitted the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Report for the month of April.

**Highway Superintendent Report**-Superintendent Dale Tamblin submitted a report for the month of April.

**Town Garage Sale**- Supervisor Lisa Worden stated that a town resident asked if Rodman could have a weekend for a town wide garage sale. Supervisor Lisa Worden suggested that it be held at the same time as the Adam's Garage sale. It was also stated that people could use the parking lot to set up as long as everything was cleaned up after the sale. All agreed.

**Comprehensive Plan**- Supervisor Lisa Worden stated there has been no changes. The tentative comprehensive plan will be sent to the Jefferson County Planning Board.

**Building Grounds Position**- Supervisor Lisa Worden introduced Ben Millard the new hire for the Building and Ground position.

Supervisor Lisa Worden and Superintendent Dale Tamblin had a meeting with Tyler Grandjean about how his duties may change over time now that Ben is overseeing the transfer station. Mr. Grandjean is fine with the possible upcoming changes.

**OLD/NEW**

Superintendent Dale Tamblin submitted a quote for \$50,000 to pave the walking path. All agreed there may be grants available to help cover the cost.

After some discussion on a new Grader Superintendent Dale Tamblin will be getting 3 quotes for June's meeting.

Supervisor Lisa Worden read a positive letter from town resident Jed Wall about the Hometown Hero Flags that were hung around town.

General and highway bills numbered 126-168 in the total amount of \$136,205.82 were audited and ordered paid for the month of April.

Supervisor Lisa Worden made a motion to adjourn at 7:40 pm.
